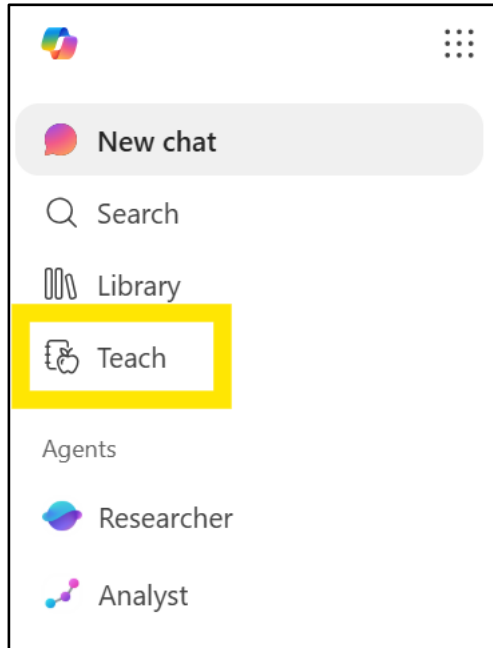

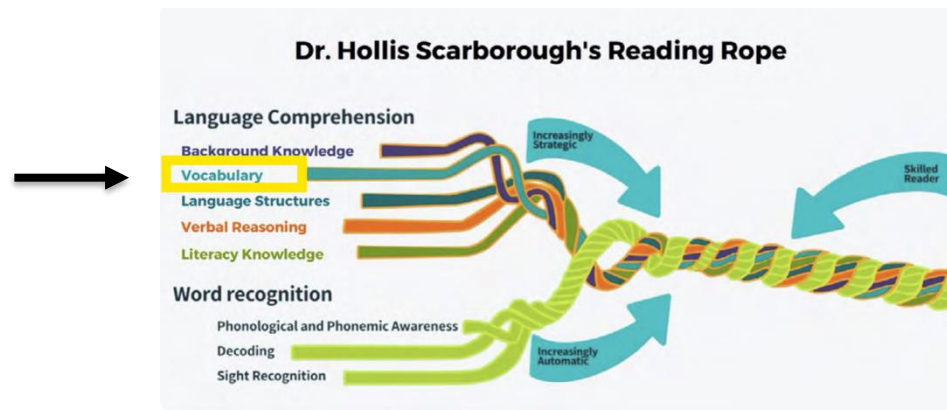
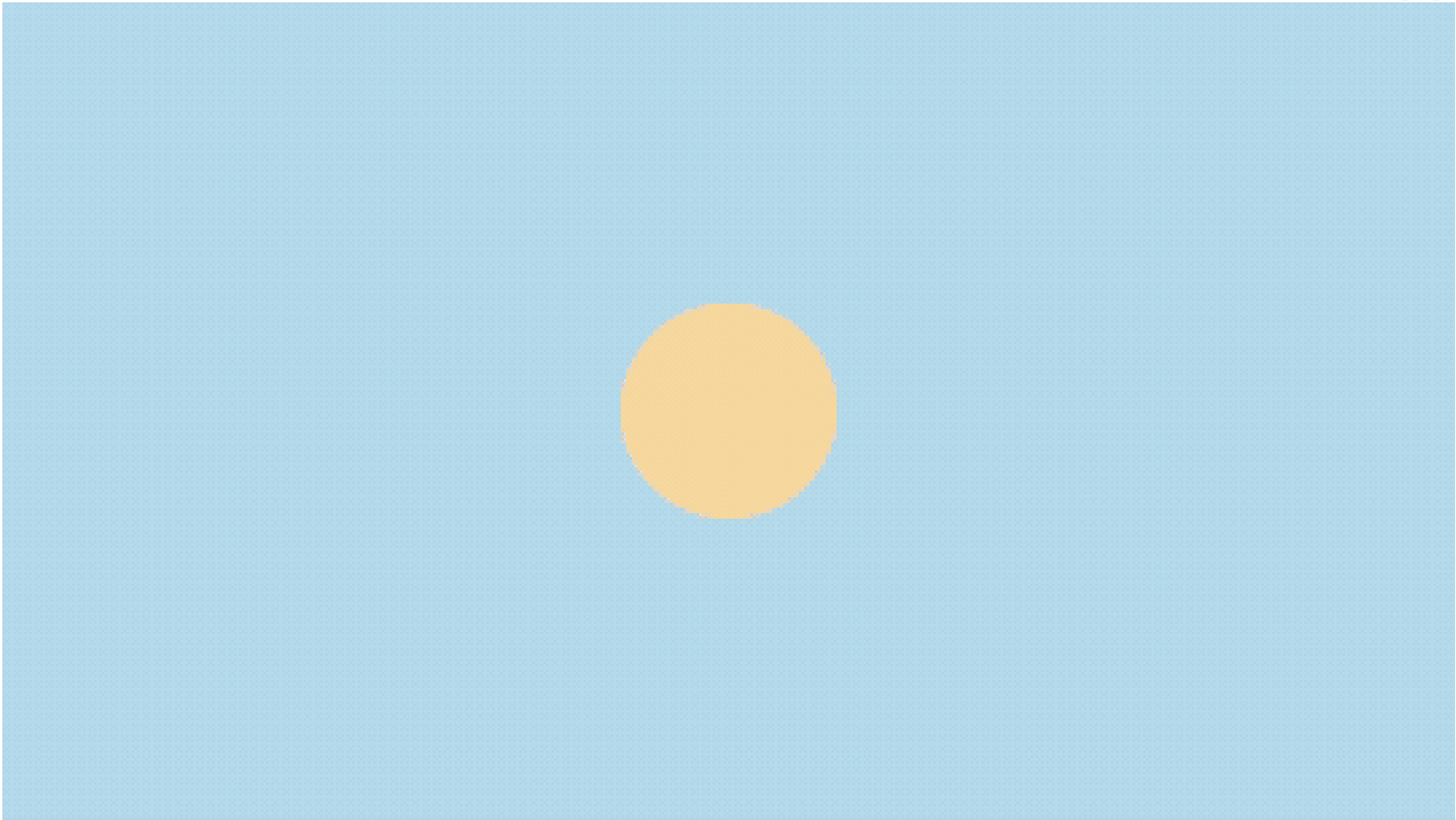


Table 3: FAST ELA Reading Grades 3-10 Percentage of Points by Reporting Category

Reading Across Genres & Vocabulary	35–50%

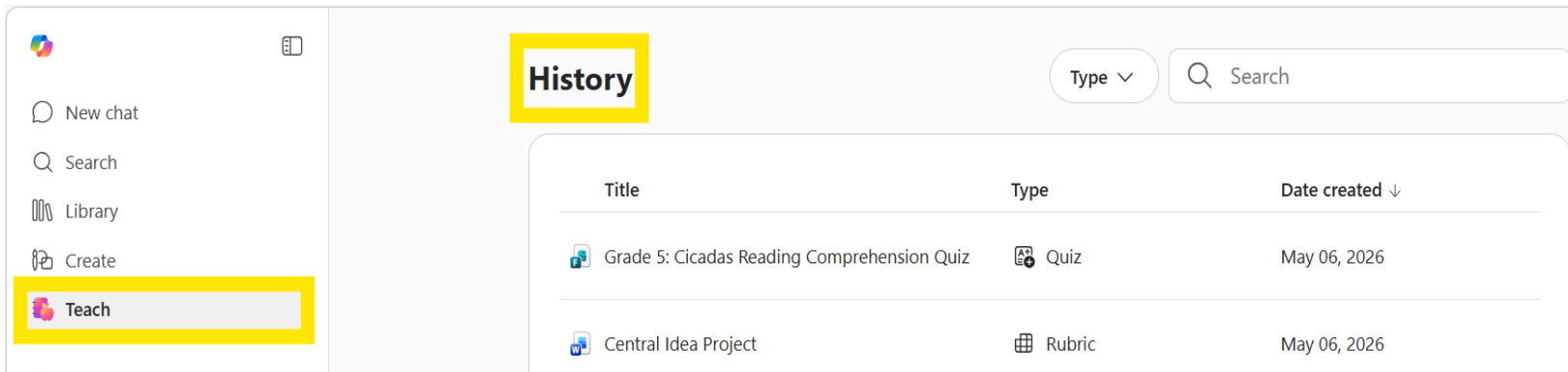
Classroom Applications
